Please use the following “Good Test” as a self evaluation to see if you will pass life’s greatest test.

Do you consider yourself to be a good person?		
Have you ever told a lie? This includes fibs, white lies and half truths.	Yes	No

Have you ever hated anyone? If someone hates another person they are a murderer. ¹	Yes	No

How did you go?

If you answered “yes” to any one of the questions, unfortunately you have broken God’s law.

These questions are part of God’s Ten Commandments³- the standard by which we are all judged when we die and stand before God. When God judges you by this standard, will you be innocent or guilty? Listen to your conscience, if you’re honest, you would admit being guilty. The Bible states “for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.” Anyone who has broken even one of the commandments is condemned to an eternity in hell.⁴

Having broken God’s law, how will you pay for your crimes (sin) on judgment day? The Bible states that our good deeds are of no value to God.⁵ God is so holy and so righteous that He cannot allow any sin. So God, in His mercy, knew you could not pay for your sins and therefore made a way for your debt to be settled. God sent His perfect, sinless Son, Jesus Christ to take the punishment we deserve and to die a painful death on a cross as payment for our sin against God. He died a criminal’s death, not because He broke the Law, but because we have. “God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.”⁶ Jesus then rose from the dead and defeated death: “The wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”⁷

Please repent (turn from and forsake your sin) and put your complete trust in Jesus as your Saviour and Lord. Your tomorrow is not guaranteed - today is the day of salvation.⁸ Read the Bible daily and obey what you read. A good place to start is the Gospel of John.
